## COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA NOTICE

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act (PL 93-198)(the Act), the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 1-2 on first and second readings April 15, 1975, and April 29, 1975, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on May 28, 1975, the legislation was assigned Act No. 1-16 and transmitted to both Houses of Congress for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional review period has expired and, therefore, cites the following legislation as D. C. Law No. 1-11, effective August 1, 1975.

D. C. Law No. 1-11

In the Council of the District of Columbia
August 1, 1975

To amend the Act of August 30, 1964 to declare the birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. to be an official holiday.

Be it enacted by the Council of the District of Columbia, That this act may be cited as the "King Birthday Act."

## Sec. 102. Findings and Purposes.

- (a) The Council of the District of Columbia wishes to commemorate in an appropriate manner the birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., to acknowledge an honor:
- (1) His leadership in the struggle for moral principles of government and humane treatment of persons in all nations of the world;
- (2) His leadership and lifetime dedication against discrimination, war and racisa;
- (3) His leadership in the struggle for civil rights of all Americans, and in particular the quest for self-determination for the District of Columbia.
- (b) The Council of the District of Columbia further finds that there is now no holiday in the District of Columbia in commemoration of the contributions of any Black citizen.

## Sec. 103. Amendment of Act of Agusut 30, 1964

Section 28-2701 of the Act of August 30, 1964 (P.L. 88-509; 78 Stat. 667) is amended by inserting the following immediately after the first semicolon: "the fifteenth day of January, commonly called Dr. King's Birthday;".

## Sec. 104. Effective Date.

This act becomes effective on the 31st day after submission to the Speaker of the House and President of the Senate provided that a resolution disapproving this act has not been adopted by the Congress (P.L. 93-198); 87 Stat. 714).
