Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia
Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act (PL 93-198),
the Act, the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill
No. 1-241 on first and second readings November 23, 1976, and
December 7, 1976, respectively. Following the signature of the
Mayor on January 11, 1977, this legislation was assigned Act
No. 1-203, published in the January 28, 1977, edition of the
D.C. Register, and transmitted to both Houses of Congress for
a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired and, therefore, cites the following legislation as D. C. Law 1-113, effective April 7, 1977.

## IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

## April 7, 1977

To amend the Act entitled "An act to establish a District of Columbia Armory Board, and for other purposes," and the District of Columbia Stadium Act of 1957.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
That this act may be cited as "The 1976 District of Columbia
Armory Board Amendment Act".

- Sec. 2. The Act entitled "An Act to establish a District of Columbia Armory Board, and for other purposes", approved June 4, 1948, is amended as follows:
- (1) Section 6(j) of such Act (D.C. Code, sec. 2-1706(j)) is amended (A) by striking out "\$50,000" and inserting in lieu thereof "\$200,000" and (B) by striking out "\$10,000" and inserting in lieu thereof "\$50,000".
- (2) Section 8 of such Act (D.C. Code, sec. 2-1708) is amended (A) by striking out "\$100,000" each place it appears and inserting in lieu thereof "\$400,000" at each such place, and (B) striking out "\$10,000" and inserting in lieu thereof "\$20,000".

Sec. 3. Section 6(a) of the District of Columbia Stadium Let of 957 (D.C. Code, sec. 2-1724(a)) is amended by inserting immediately after the third sentence the following new sentence: "The Board is further authorized to make advances, not to exceed \$15,000 at any one time, from such working capital fund to be used in connection with the expenses of operating concessions at the stadium, including use for change-making purposes."

Sec. 4. Severability: If any section or provision of this act is held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections or provisions of this act.

Sec. 5. This act-shall take effect at the end of the period provided for Congressional review of acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in Subsection (c) of Section 602 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act.
