COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA NOTICE

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, PL 93-198 (the Act), the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 1-86 on October 7, 1975, and October 21, 1975, respectively. Following the Mayor's signature on November 7, 1975, this legislation was assigned Act No. 1-64, published in the November 26, 1975, edition of the <u>D.C. Register</u>, and transmitted to both Houses of Congress for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional review period has expired and, therefore, cites the following legislation as D.C. Law No. 1-46, effective February 19, 1976.

To provide for access to all duly licensed clinical psychologists without prior referral in private health plans.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the "Access to Psychologists and Optometrists Act".

- Sec. 2. Section 12, Chapter V, of "An Act to regulate the business of life insurance in the District of Columbia", approved June 19, 1934 (48 Stat. 1166), as amended (D.C. Code, sec. 35-712), is hereby amended-
- (1) By adding to subsection (a) of "2. Form of Policy", the following new paragraph (8):
 - "(8) it contains no provision which would restrict access to psychologists or optometrists. When a policy relating to health insurance requires payment or reimbursement for services which may be performed by a duly licensed psychologist or optometrist, any person covered by the policy shall be free to select and have direct access to such psychologist or optometrist

without supervision or referral by a practitioner of the healing art and shall be entitled under the policy, if applicable, to have payment or reimbursement made for services performed."

(2) At the end of paragraph (7), by striking the period, inserting a semi-colon in lieu thereof, and adding the word "and".

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect as provided for acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 602(c) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act.
