COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA NOTICE

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, PL 93-198 (the Act), the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 1-51 on November 4, 1975 and November 18, 1975, respectively. Following the Mayor's signature on December 4, 1975, this legislation was assigned Act No. 1-73, published in the December 12, 1975, edition of the D.C. Register, and transmitted to both Houses of Congress for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(l) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional review period has expired and, therefore, cites the following legislation as D.C. Law 1-53, effective March 12, 1976.

In the Council of the District of Columbia

March 12, 1976

To authorize administrative or supervisory school officers who are granted sabbatical leave to receive one-half of their annual salaries.

BE IT FTACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
That this act may be cited as the "School Officers
Sabbatical Leave Act".

- Sec. 2. Section 4 of the Act entitled "An Act to provide educational employees of the public schools of the District of Columbia with leave of absence, with part pay, for purposes of educational improvement, and for other purposes," approved June 12, 1940 (D.C. Code, sec. 31-635) is amended by striking out "or equal to the largest amount to which any employee in the salary class of elementary and secondary school teachers would be entitled if given educational leave, whichever is less, either" and inserting in lieu thereof a comma and the word "such".
- Sec. 3. The amendment made by this act shall become effective on the first day of the first pay period which begins on or after the sixtieth day occurring after the date this act becomes law according to the provisions of section 602(c) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act.
