
NOTICE

D.C. Law 1-83--"District of Columbia
Aging Act Amendments".

September 24, 1976

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, PL 93-198 (the Act), the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 1-249 on first and second readings May 6, 1976 and May 20, 1976, respectively. Following the Mayor's signature on June 18, 1976, this legislation was assigned Act No. 1-132, published in the JUNE 29, 1976 edition of the D.C. Register, and transmitted to both Houses of Congress for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c) (1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional review period has expired and, therefore, cites the following legislation as D.C. Law 1-83, effective September 14, 1976.

D.C. LAW 1-83

In the Council of the District of Columbia

September 14, 1976

To amend D.C. Law No. 1-24, the District of Columbia Act on the Aging.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
That this act may be cited as the "District of Columbia Aging Act Amendments".

Sec. 2. Section 303 of the District of Columbia Act on the Aging (D.C. Law No. 1-24) is amended as follows:

(a) In subsection 5., insert after "Office" the following phrase: "and an analysis of the needs of the aged".

(b) In subsection 9., after "Commission" insert "for comment."

(c) Add the following new subsection:

"11. Review and comment on proposed District and Federal legislation, regulations, policies, and programs and make policy recommendations on issues affecting the health, safety, and welfare of the aged."

Sec. 3. Section 410 of the District of Columbia Act on the Aging (D.C. Law No. 1-24) is amended by deleting

subsections B., C., D., and H. and replacing them with the following new subsections:

"B. Review and submit to the Mayor, the Council of the District of Columbia, and the Office on Aging, an annual report including comments on the analysis of the needs of the aged in the District of Columbia made in the report of the Director.

"C. Advise the Director on cooperation with Federal, state, and private agencies concerned with activities pertaining to the aged.

"D. Review and comment on the annual state plan required under the Older Americans Act. The statement of the Commission shall be transmitted to the Department of Health, Education and Welfare with the plan.

"H. Review and comment on the Director's review of proposed District and Federal legislation, regulations, policies and programs, and comment on the Director's policy recommendations on issues affecting the health, safety, and welfare of the aged."

Sec. 4. This act shall be effective immediately at the end of the thirty day period (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, holidays, and days on which either House of Congress is not in session) beginning on the date this act is submitted to the Congress, as provided in section 602(c) of the District
