IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend the New Town at Capital City Market Revitalization Development and Public/Private Partnership Act of 2006 to redefine the geographical boundaries of the Capital City Market.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "New Town Boundary Amendment Act of 2008".

Sec. 2. Section 202(1) of the New Town at Capital City Market Revitalization Development and Public/Private Partnership Act of 2006, effective March 14, 2007 (D.C. Law 16-278; D.C. Official Code § 6-1062.02(1)), is amended by striking the phrase ""Capital City Market" means the approximately 24-acre site bounded by Florida Avenue, N.E., on the south, 6th Street, N.E., on the east, Penn Street, N.E., on the north, and the railroad tracks and Metro rail on the west in northeast Washington, D.C., in Ward 5." and inserting the phrase ""Capital City Market" or "Market" means the approximately 24-acre site bounded by Florida Avenue on the south, 5th Street on the east, Penn Street on the north, and the railroad tracks and Metro rail on the west in northeast Washington, D.C., in Ward 5" in its place.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the October 16, 2008 fiscal impact statement of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

Sec. 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
