
NOTICE

D.C. Law 2-111

"Official Purposes Funds Act of 1978"

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 2-334, on first and second readings June 13, 1978 and June 27, 1978, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on July 17, 1978, this legislation was assigned Act No. 2-232, published in the August 11, 1978, edition of the D.C. Register and transmitted to both Houses of Congress for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired and, therefore, cites the following legislation as D.C. Law 2-111, effective September 23, 1978.

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

September 23, 1978

To authorize the expenditure of funds by Council Members for official purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
That this act may be cited as the "Official Purpose Funds Act
of 1978".

Sec. 2. The first sentence of section 26 of An Act to
authorize certain programs and activities of the government of
the District of Columbia, approved October 26, 1973 (87 Stat.
509; D.C. Code, sec. 1-262a, and sec. 31-1122), is amended to
read as follows:

"The Mayor of the District of Columbia, the Chairman
and Members of the Council of the District of Columbia, the
Superintendent of Schools, and the Chief Executive Officer
of the University of the District of Columbia are each
hereby authorized to provide for the expenditure, within
the limits of specified annual appropriation, of funds for
appropriate purposes related to their official capacity as
they may respectively deem necessary.".

Sec. 3. Section 301(b) The District of Columbia Public Postsecondary Education Reorganization Act Amendments, effective November 1, 1975 (D.C. Law 1-36; D.C. Code, sec. 31-1721(b)), is hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect as provided for acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act.
