IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

MARCH 16, 1978

To exempt all veterans in the District of Columbia who are totally and permanently disabled from paying the applicable motor vehicle registration fee for their personal noncommercial motor vehicles.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
That this act may be cited as the "District of Columbia's
Disabled Veterans Exemption Act of 1977".

Sec. 2. Section 3 of the Act of August 17, 1937 (50
Stat. 681; D.C. Code, sec. 40-103) is amended by adding new
subsections (f) and (g) to read as follows:

"(f) No annual motor vehicle registration fee shall
be required for a noncommercial motor vehicle owned
by any veteran who has been classified by the
United States Veterans Administration, as totally
and permanently disabled as a result of a service
~~incurred or aggravated condition: PROVIDED,~~ PROVIDED, That no
more than one (1) such vehicle per qualified
veteran shall receive this fee exemption.

"(g) The Mayor shall direct the Director of the
Department of Transportation to design and provide
application forms for the exemption provided in

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subsection (f) of this section. The application shall be accompanied by a statement that the veteran has been classified as totally and permanently disabled by the Veterans Administration so as to meet the requirements of this subsection, and that such disability is the result of a service incurred or aggravated condition."

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect according to the provisions of section 602(c) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act.
