
NOTICE

D.C. Law 3-159

"Office of Consumer Protection Administrative Law Judge Act of 1980".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 3-339 on first and second readings, October 14, 1980 and October 28, 1980, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on November 10, 1980, this legislation was assigned Act No. 3-286, published in the November 21, 1980 edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 27 page 5147). This act was originally transmitted to Congress on November 19, 1980, and resubmitted on January 14, 1981 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 3-159, effective March 5, 1981.

D.C. ACT 3-286

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

NOV 10 1980

To permit the appointment of administrative law judges to the Section of Hearings of the Office of Consumer Protection, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the "Office of Consumer Protection Administrative Law Judge Act of 1980".

Sec. 2.(a) D.C. Code, sec. 28-3902(e) is amended to read as follows:

"(e) The Mayor shall appoint to the Section of Hearings one or more attorneys qualified to serve as administrative law judges. In making such appointments, the Mayor may appoint a panel of such qualified attorneys whose members shall serve as administrative law judges from time to time in accordance with a system of selection, such as rotation, designation, or otherwise, and

at such compensation as the Mayor shall prescribe by rule."

(b) D.C. Code, sec. 28-3905(d) is amended by inserting following the phrase "the Director shall" the phrase ", absent good cause for delay as determined by the Section of Hearings,".


(c) D.C. Code, sec. 28-3905(e) is amended by striking the phrase "within 45 days after determining the reasonable grounds provided for in subsection (d), and in no event later than 105 days after the complaint is filed, the Director shall" and inserting the phrase "within 180 days after the complaint is filed, the Director shall, absent good cause for delay as determined by the Section of Hearings:" in lieu thereof.


Sec. 3. All cases for which complaints were filed before the effective date of this act may be presented to and heard by the Section of Hearings notwithstanding the time limits previously provided in D.C. Code, sections 28-3905(d), 28-3905(e), and 28-3905(f) for the investigation and transmittal of cases to the Section of Hearings, and for the hearing of cases by the Section of Hearings.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect after a thirty (30) day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973, (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code, sec. 1-147(c)(1)).
