

D. C. LAW 3-60

"Property Tax Relief Application Deadline Extension Act of 1979"

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 3-210, on first and second readings, January 22, 1980 and February 5, 1980 respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on February 26, 1980, this legislation was assigned Act No. 3-156, published in the March 7, 1980, edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 27 page 987) and transmitted to Congress on March 3, 1980 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and, therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 3-60 effective April 23, 1980.

AN ACT

D.C. ACT 3 - 156

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

FEB 26 1980

To extend the deadline for filing the application for the homestead exemption and Class One Property tax rate for Tax Year 1980, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the "Property Tax Relief Application Deadline Extension Act of 1979".

Sec. 2. Section 3(c)(2) of the Residential Property Tax Relief Act of 1977, effective February 28, 1978 (D.C. Law 2-45; D.C. Code, sec. 47-659.1(c)(2)), as amended by the Real Property Tax Classifications Act for Tax Year 1980, effective November 20, 1979 (D.C. Law 3-37; 26 DCR 2515), is amended to read as follows:

"(2)(A) In order to obtain the deduction provided for under this subsection, owners of eligible real property shall

complete and file with the District of Columbia Department of Finance and Revenue (hereinafter, referred to as the "Department") on or before June 1 preceding the tax year, an application form devised by the Department.


"(B) For the tax year beginning July 1, 1979, and ending June 30, 1980, the application form required by section 3(c)(2)(A) shall be completed and filed with the Department on or before November 30, 1979. Prior to November 30, 1979, the Department shall mail such application to all residential real property owners for whose residential real property no such application was received by the Department as of July 1, 1979. If such application is filed with the Department in person, the real property owner so filing shall be given a receipt for the application. If such application is mailed to the Department, the Department shall mail a receipt to the real property owner so filing:


PROVIDED, That the real property owner so filing encloses a stamped self-addressed envelope with his application.

"(C) In the case of real property owners who take advantage of the extended filing period provided for in this section for the tax year beginning July 1, 1979, and ending June 30, 1980, the appropriate adjustments to real property tax liabilities shall be reflected in the second-half tax bills which are due and payable on March 31, 1980. No adjustment shall be made to first-half tax bills which are already issued and which were due and payable by September 17, 1979."

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect after a thirty (30) day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the

District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 502(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 913; D.C. Code, sec. 1-147(c)(1)).
