
NOTICE

D.C. LAW 4-108

"District of Columbia Administration of Oaths, Public Assistance Technical Clarification, and Police Service and Fire Service Schedule Approval Act of 1982".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 4-397 on first and second readings, February 23, 1982 and March 9, 1982, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on March 26, 1982, this legislation was assigned Act No. 4-169, published in the April 2, 1982 edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 29 page 1413) and transmitted to Congress on April 1, 1982 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 4-108, effective May 19, 1982.

D.C. ACT 4 - 169

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

MAR 26 1982

To empower the Mayor of the District of Columbia, the Chairman of the Council of the District of Columbia, and members of the Council of the District of Columbia to administer oaths as part of their official duties, at no charge and not to be used for personal purposes; to make a technical amendment to the District of Columbia Public Assistance Act of 1982; to notify and authorize the Police Service and Fire Service pay schedules; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
That this act may be cited as the "District of Columbia Administration of Oaths, Public Assistance Technical Clarification, and Police Service and Fire Service Schedule Approval Act of 1982".

Sec. 2. The Mayor of the District of Columbia, the Chairman of the Council of the District of Columbia, and the members of the Council of the District of Columbia may administer oaths as part of their official responsibilities. No fee shall be collected for the administration of such oaths, and the power to administer such oaths shall not be utilized for personal purposes.

Public Assistance Act of 1982 (Council Bill 4-369) is amended by adding a new subsection (d) at the end thereof to read as follows:

"(d) The table set forth in this section shall be used for all payments and eligibility determinations made after January 31, 1982."



Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1106 of the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Code, sec. 1-612.6), the Police Service Schedule, as transmitted by the Mayor of the District of Columbia on December 7, 1981, is approved effective December 14, 1981, and the Fire Service Schedule, as transmitted by the Mayor of the District of Columbia on February 19, 1982, is approved effective February 22, 1982.



This act shall take effect after a thirty (30)-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved

December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code, sec. 1-233(c)(1)).
