D.C. LAW 4-114

"Assistance to Neglected Children Funding Authorization Act of 1982".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 4-411 on first and second readings, March 23, 1982 and April 6, 1982, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on April 12, 1982, this legislation was assigned Act No. 4-177, published in the April 23, 1982 edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 29 page 1699) and transmitted to Congress on April 20, 1982 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 4-114, effective June 4, 1982.

To amend D.C. Code, sec. 16-2304 to authorize the payment of fees to attorneys who represent children or other parties in neglect proceedings in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this bill may be cited as the "Assistance to Neglected Children Funding Authorization Act of 1982".


Sec. 2. D.C. Code, sec. 16-2304 is amended by adding to the end thereof the following new subsections to read as follows:

"(c) Prior to appointment of counsel under this section, the eligibility of a child or other party to be represented by counsel shall be determined by the Division pursuant to rules established by the Superior Court of the District of Columbia.


"(d) There are authorized to be appropriated such funds as may be necessary for the administration of this section."

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect after a thirty (30)-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
