D.C. LAW 4-193

"Youth Employment Act of 1979 Amendments/Job Skills and Placement Programs for Public Housing Residents Act of 1982".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 4-331 on first and second readings, November 16, 1982, and December 14, 1982, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on December 28, 1982, this legislation was assigned Act No. 4-277, published in the January 7, 1983, edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 30 page 46) and transmitted to Congress on January 7, 1983 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Perjod has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 4-193, effective March 10, 1983.

D.C. ACT 4-277

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

DEC 28 1982

To amend the Youth Employment Act of 1979 to assure that public housing residents participate in employment and training programs administered by the District of Columbia government, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
That this act may be cited as the "Youth Employment Act of
1979 Amendments/Job Skills and Placement Programs for Public
Housing Residents Act of 1982".

Sec. 2. Section 2(a) of the Youth Employment Act of C 1979, effective January 5, 1980 (D.C. Law 3-46; D.C. Code, sec. 36-702(a)) is amended as follows:

(a) Paragraph (3) is amended to read as follows:

"(3) Out of School Year-Round Employment. An Out of School Year-Round Employment Program to provide for the employment of youth sixteen (16) through twenty-four (24) years of age at the prevailing entry-level wage for the job being performed, not to exceed \$3.25 per hour during fiscal years 1979 and 1980, and thereafter not to exceed a wage twelve percent (12%) greater than the federal minimum wage. Priority for employment under this program shall be given to economically disadvantaged youth with special consideration given to public housing residents. The program shall have special safeguards to assure that the prospect of employment

under this act does not induce students to drop out of school.".

- (b) Paragraph (4) is amended to read as follows:
- "(4) On-the-Job Training for Adults with Dependents Program. A program of on-the-job training for five hundred (500) adults at least twenty-two (22) years of age with one (1) or more dependents, for a period of twelve (12) months at the prevailing entry-level wage for the job being performed, not to exceed five dollars (\$5.00) per hour, under which the employer shall pay an average of one-half (1/2) of the employee's total wage cost for the period, in accordance with a schedule to be adopted by the Mayor. Priority for participation in the program shall be given to economically disadvantaged adults with dependents, with special consideration given to public housing residents. The Mayor shall appoint immediately a task force, consisting of, but not limited to, the Mayor's Special Assistant on Youth, the Director of the Department of Employment Services, representatives of the Minority Business Opportunity Commission, the Director of the Office of Business and Economic Development, and a representative of the Council of the District of Columbia. The task force shall identify and contact employers within the private sector, with emphasis on minority businesses, in order to implement this program. The Mayor shall encourage participating employers to retain employees hired under the program after the one (1)-year period.".

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect after a 30-day

riod of Congressional review following approval by the tyor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the funcil of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as movided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia alf-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, proved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code, sec. -233(c)(1)).
