D.C. LAW 4-31

"Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Bicycle Permit Program Act of 1981".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 4-216 on first and second readings, May 19, 1981 and June 2, 1981, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on June 19, 1981, this legislation was assigned Act No. 4-53, published in the July 10, 1981 edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 28 page 3120) and transmitted to Congress on June 24, 1981 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 4-31, effective September 18, 1981.

To authorize the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority to issue permits that allow individuals who hold such a permit to carry bicycles on Metrorail; to amend the Act to Regulate Public Conduct on Public Passenger Vehicles; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.

That this act may be cited as the "washington

Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Bicycle Permit

Sec. 2. Section 2 of An Act to Regulate

Public Conduct on Public Passenger Venicles.

effective February 22. 1978 (D.C. Law 1-18; D.C.

Code. sec. 44-216) is amended as follows:

- (a) Redesignate existing section 2 as subsection (b) and insert the following text designated as subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) For the purposes of this act, the term 'Rail Transit Station' means a regular rail stopping place for the bick-up and discharge of passengers in regular route service, contract service, special or community-type service.

including the fare-paid areas and roofed areas of the Rail Transit Stations (not bus terminals or bus stops) owned, operated, or controlled by the washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority: PROVIDED, That the term 'rail transit station' shall not include parking lots, roadways and other areas intended for venicle traffic.

- (b) In paragraph (6) delete the phrase "packaged; or" and insert the word "packaged" in lieu thereof.
- (c) In paragraph (7) delete the word
 "operator." and insert the word "operator;" in
 lieu thereof.
- (d) Add the following new paragraphs at the end thereof to read as follows:
 - "(8) park+ operate, wheel+ or chain
 to any fence, tree+ railing+ or
 other structure not
 specifically designated for
 such use+ tricycles+ unicycles+
 skateboards+ or roller skates;
 - "(9) park. operate. carry. wheel. or
 chain to any fence. tree.
 railing. or other structure not

specifically designated for such use, mopeds, motor bikes, or any other such vehicle;

"(10) park+ operate+ carry+ wheel+ or chain to any fence, tree, railing, or other structure not specifically designated for such use, noncollapsable bicycles, unless an individual has a current permit issued by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority for the transporting of noncollapsable picycles by rail transit and the individual is complying with all the terms and conditions of said permit: PROVIDED. That an individual shall surrender said permit upon the request or demand of any agent or employee of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority. Sections 4 and 5 of this act shall not

apply to a violation of the terms and conditions of said permit.".

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect after a thirty (30)-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code, sec. 1-147(c)(1)).
