D.C. LAW 6-8

"Pregnancy Anti-Discrimination Act of 1985".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 6-45 on first and second readings, April 16, 1985, and April 30, 1985, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on May 16, 1985, this legislation was assigned Act No. 6-21, published in the May 31, 1985, edition of the <u>D.C. Register</u>, (Vol. 32 page 2959) and transmitted to Congress on May 21, 1985 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602 (c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 6-8, effective July 17, 1985.

D.C. ACT 6 - 21

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

MAY 1 6 1985

To prohibit discrimination against women on the basis of pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Pregnancy Anti-Discrimination Act of 1985".

- Sec. 2. The Human Rights Act of 1977, effective

 December 13, 1977 (D.C. Law 2-38; D.C. Code, sec. 1-2501 et

 seg.), is amended by adding a new section 105 to read as

 follows:
- "Sec. 105. (a) For the purposes of interpreting this act, discrimination on the basis of sex shall include, but not be limited to, discrimination on the basis of pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions.
- "(b) Women affected by pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions shall be treated the same for all employment related purposes, including receipt of benefits under fringe benefit programs, as other persons not so affected but similar in their ability or inability to work, and this requirement shall include, but not be limited to, a requirement that an employer must treat an employee temporarily unable to perform the functions of her job because of her pregnancy-related condition in the same

manner as it treats other temporarily disabled employees.".

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect after a 30-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(l) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code, sec. 1-233(c)(l)).
