D.C. LAW 9-1

"Board of Education Special Election Temporary
Amendment Act of 1991".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 9-97 on first and second readings, February 5, 1991, and March 5, 1991, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on March 15, 1991, this legislation was assigned Act No. 9-6, published in the April 5, 1991, edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 38 page 1958) and transmitted to Congress on March 19, 1991 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 9-1, effective May 15, 1991.

AN ACT

D.C. ACT 9-6

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

MARCH 15, 1991

To authorize, on a temporary basis, the conduct of special elections for the purpose of selecting Representatives to the District of Columbia Board of Education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Board of Education Special Election Temporary Amendment Act of 1991". Note, Section 1-229

Sec. 2.(a) Section 8(n) of an Act to regulate the election of delegates representing the District of Columbia to national political conventions, and for other purposes, approved August 12, 1955 (69 Stat. 701; D.C. Code, sec. 1-1312(n)) is amended as follows: Note, Section 1-1312

(1) By adding the phrase "or special" after the phrase "Each candidate in a general"; and

(2) By adding the phrase "or special" after the phrase "such general".


(b) Section 10(e) of An Act to regulate the election of delegates representing the District of Columbia to national political conventions, and for other purposes, approved August 12, 1955 (69 Stat. 702; D.C. Code, sec. 1-1314(e)), is amended as follows: Note, Section 1-1314


"(e)(1) In the event of a vacancy on the Board of Education, the Board of Elections and Ethics shall hold a special election to fill the vacancy on the 1st Tuesday that occurs more than 114 days after the date on which the vacancy occurs, unless the Board of Elections and Ethics determines that the vacancy could be filled more practicably in a special election held on the same day as the next special, primary, or general election to be held in the District that occurs within 60 days of the date on which a special election would otherwise have been held under the provisions of this subsection. The person elected as a member to fill a vacancy on the Board of Education shall take office on the day on which the Board of Elections and Ethics certifies his or her election.

"(2) The date of any special election called as a result of any emergency legislation enacted by the Council shall not be changed as a result of the enactment of this act."

Sec. 3. (a) This act shall take effect after a 30-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code, sec. 1-233(c)(1)), and publication in either the District of Columbia Register, the District of Columbia Statutes-at-Large, or the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.

(b) This act shall expire on the 225th day of its having taken effect or upon the effective date of the Board of Education Special Election Amendment Act of 1991, whichever occurs first.
