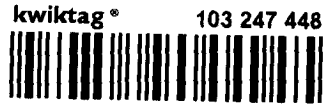



D.C. LAW 9-55

"District of Columbia Procurement Practices Act of 1985 Council Contract Approval Procedures Temporary Amendment Act of 1991".

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, P. L. 93-198, "the Act", the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill No. 9-295 on first and second readings, September 17, 1991 and October 1, 1991, respectively. On November 1, 1991, Bill No. 9-295 was vetoed by the Mayor. The Council overrode the Mayor's veto on November 5, 1991. As a result of the Council's override, Bill No. 9-295 was re-enacted and assigned Act No. 9-97. The Act was published in the November 15, 1991, edition of the D.C. Register, (Vol. 38 page 6826) and transmitted to Congress on November 12, 1991 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 30-day Congressional Review Period has expired, and therefore, cites this enactment as D.C. Law 9-55, effective February 22, 1992.

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

NOVEMBER 5, 1991

To amend, on a temporary basis, the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Act of 1985, to clarify provisions for Council review and approval prior to the award of contracts for goods or services worth more than \$1,000,000.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "District of Columbia Procurement Practices Act of 1985 Council Contract Approval Procedures Temporary Amendment Act of 1991".

Sec. 2. Section 105A of the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Act of 1985, effective March 8, 1991 (D.C. Law 8-257; D.C. Code §1-1181.5a) is amended to read as follows: Note, Section 1-1181.5a

"Sec. 105A. Council approval of contracts prior to award.

"(a)(1) After the effective date of the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Act of 1985 Council Contract Approval Procedures Emergency Amendment Act of 1991, no contract for goods or services worth over \$1,000,000 may be awarded until after the Council has approved the proposed contract award as provided in this section.

"(2) Prior to the award of a contract covered by this section, the Mayor shall submit a proposed contract award to the Council. The proposed contract award shall be deemed approved 7 calendar days, excluding days of Council recess, after the proposal has been officially introduced in the Council according to its rules, unless during that time, an objection to the proposed award is filed in the Office of the Secretary to the Council. An objection to a proposed contract award shall be signed by at least 3 members of the Council.

"(3) If an objection to the proposed contract award is filed, the proposed award shall be deemed approved 21 calendar days, excluding days of Council recess, after the proposed award was officially introduced in the Council, unless during that time, the Council adopts a resolution disapproving the proposed award.

"(4) The Council may approve or disapprove a proposed contract award by resolution prior to the expiration of the time periods provided in this section.

"(b) The approval required by this section shall be a condition precedent to the existence of a District of Columbia contract for goods or services worth over \$1,000,000. No contractor may undertake any work, and no District officer or employee may obligate or expend funds,


with respect to the performance of a proposed contract prior to Council approval under this section.

"(c) This section shall not apply to contracts awarded under the 'competitive sealed bidding' provisions pursuant to section 303 of this act.

"(d) This section shall not apply to contracts to implement a federal program where federal law governs contracting procedures as a condition for the receipt of federal assistance."

Sec. 3. (a) This act shall take effect after a 30-day period of Congressional review following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council of the District of Columbia to override the veto) as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code §1-233(c)(1)), and publication in either the District of Columbia Register, the District of Columbia Statutes-at-Large, or the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.

(b) This act shall expire on the 225th day of its having taken effect or upon the effective date of the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Act of 1985 Council Contract Approval Procedures Amendment Act of 1991 whichever occurs first.


